**New Year 7 Parents' Evening – Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July 2018 from 6.00 pm to 7.00 pm.**  
**Pupils' Induction Day – Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> July 2018 from 9.00 am to 3.30 pm.**

I am writing to invite you to St Michael's Catholic College for two important events - **Parents' Evening on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> July from 6.00 pm to 7.00 pm.** to which all parents are expected to attend. Your son/daughter should accompany you to this event and **Induction Day for pupils' on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> July from 9.00 am until 3.30 pm.** This day is compulsory; therefore it is essential that your child is present. Please note that this date is set by the local education authority and is the same across all schools and colleges in this and neighbouring boroughs thus all pupils must attend.

**Parents' Evening:** During this evening you will receive a Parents' Information Envelope which contains important forms for completion and details of the College uniform together with a pack from our uniform suppliers – Whitehall Clothiers itemising details of uniform and discount vouchers to assist with the cost. You will also learn more of the College's ethos, standards we expect from pupils, the importance of the College Journal, Homework and information on how the College operates.

**Pupils' Induction Day:** On this day pupils should arrive at the college for 9.00 am prompt. They should wear their primary school uniform if he/she has one and bring along writing pens and pencils. **It is extremely important that you provide your son/daughter with lunch money - £2.30, (exact money is vital as we do not have access to change) in order to purchase a lunch from our College Cafeteria. We have provided an envelope with your child's name on for you to enclose the lunch money.**

Most of the morning will be taken up with CATs Tests, the results of which will determine his/her teaching group for September 2018, hence the compulsion to attend. Throughout the afternoon your son/daughter will participate in 'taster' lessons across a range of subjects. Pupils will be dismissed at 3.30 pm and may go home with a brother or sister if one attends the College. Finally please complete the Language Preference form enclosed, indicating your son/daughter's preference to study either French or Spanish and return it to the college as soon as possible. We look forward to meeting with you on these two dates at the beginning of a long and successful partnership between College and home.
