



Year of the Word

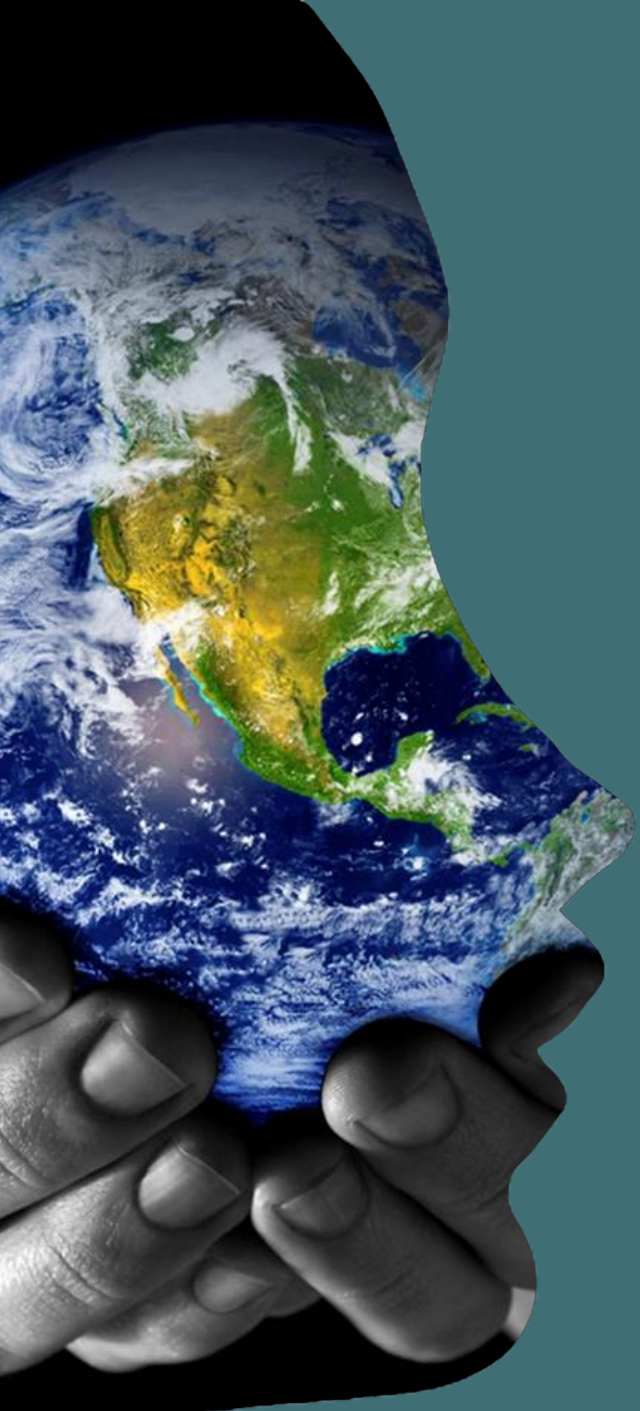


We are delighted to have launched the Year of the Word in our assemblies this week.
