
We pray that you will bless us and our families during our summer holiday. May we all help make our home a place of relaxation, joy, love, peace and safety.

- Lourdes trip- Miss Caden and Mr Mahon accompanied a group of year 12 students to Lourdes in the week 1st July-5th July. The group visited the world-famous town in southwestern France. They

- visited the Grotto of Massabielle (Grotto of the Apparitions) where, in 1858, the Virgin Mary is said to have appeared seventeen times to a local woman-St Bernadette.
- £750 raised for charity year 7 students have been taking part this year in a business and enterprise project run by Grant Thornton, one of the world's largest accounting and consultancy firms, where they have been raising money to support a small start-up business in the developing world. All the students involved managed to raise a total of £750 for a young Palestinian entrepreneur who has started his own business and will use some of the money above to buy tables and chairs for his café.

The places to be visited has been kept top secret until Sports day (9th July) and they have been known as "mystery trips" and include visits to Thorpe Park, Southend, at day at the O2 and the British Musuem.
