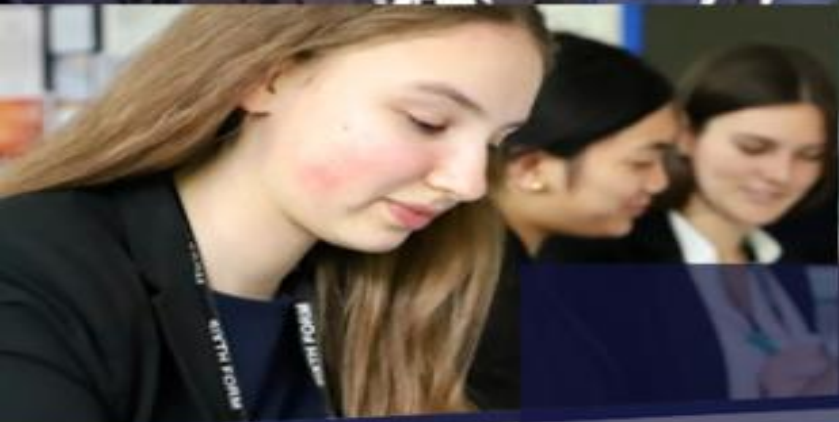

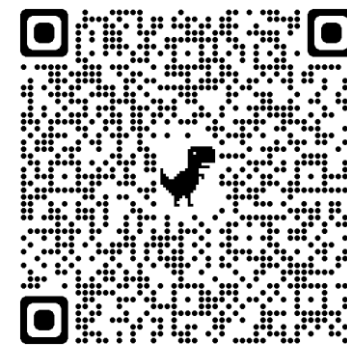

# Rua Charity Week Appeal



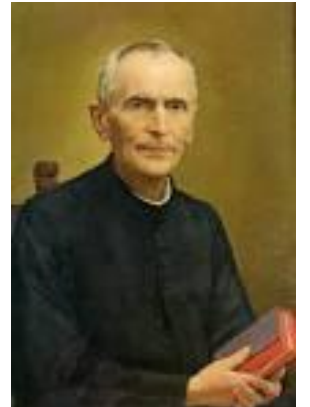
This year – Rua House are supporting people in our local area who are homeless
