Berlin 2024 – Year 12

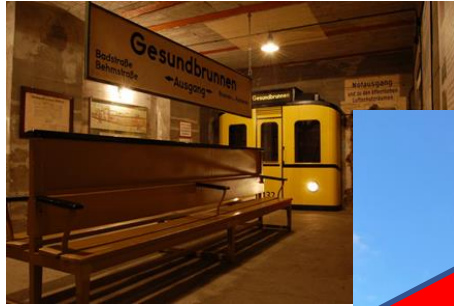

- Breakfast, Dinner, flight

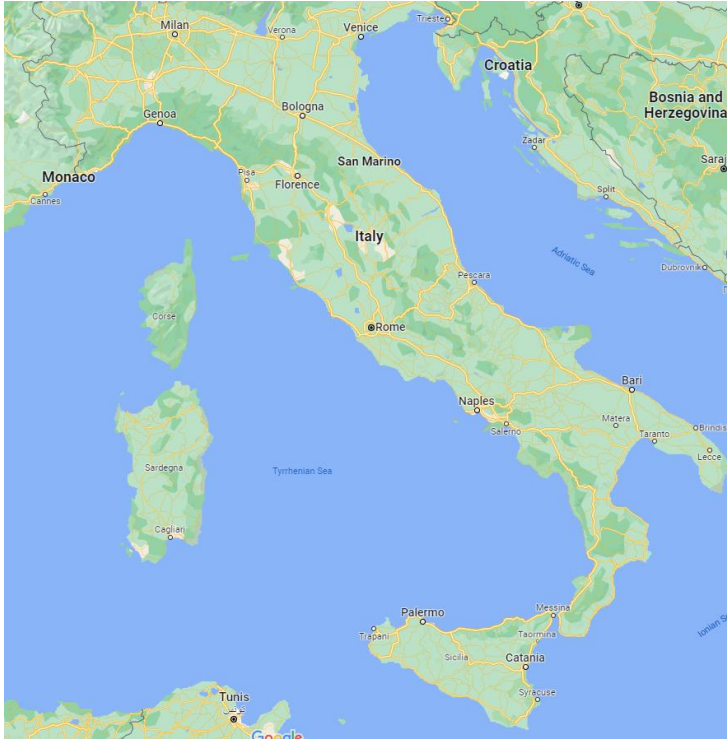

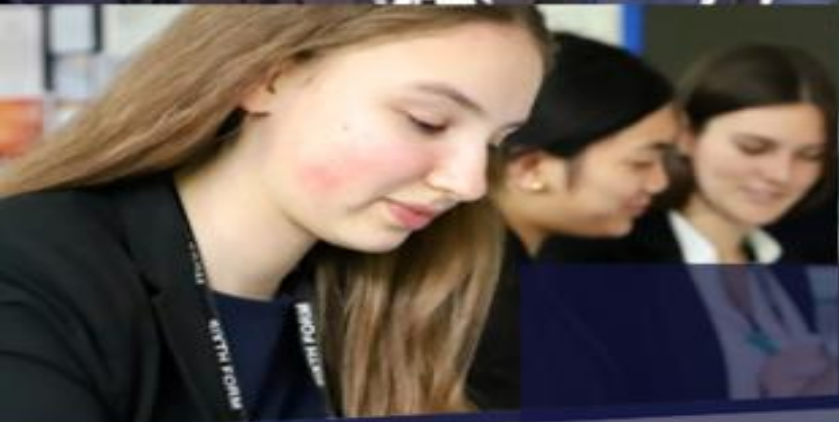

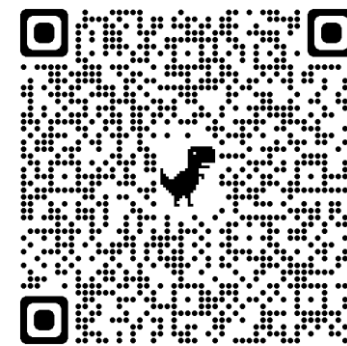

Year 11 Geographers will be out all day at Epping Forest as part of their field work for the GCSE course leaving at 8.30am on Friday morning.

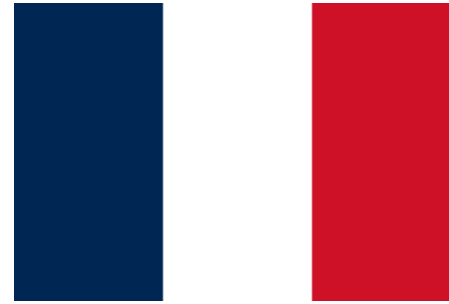
