We are writing to you with information about the upcoming face-to-face Year 11 Parents Evening, which provides you with the opportunity to discuss your child's progress with their subject teachers at St Michael's.

As you can appreciate, where some teachers teach significant numbers of students, there might be limited free appointment slots as they get booked up by parents/carers. If there are no appointment slots left and it is urgent that you speak to that member of staff, please contact the school to make an alternative time to discuss your son/daughter's progress.

Please note the event must be attended to inform next steps for your child. The partnership between parents/carers and St Michael's is crucial and has a positive impact upon your child's academic success.

- You will be asked for a login code to access the appointment page, which will be given to your child.
- Your schedule of appointments will be sent to your email address.
- Appointments can be booked from 12pm on Thursday 14th December and by 12pm on Wednesday 10th January.
- Please arrive before your first appointment.
- During the evening, there will be a clock on the screen in both the Main Hall and Canteen as appointments will end after exactly five minutes. A colleague will prompt parents to move every five minutes.

On the day, we want parents and students to have the best possible experience. Please note:

- You should arrive into reception from 15:45 or five minutes before your first appointment.
- No parking is available at the College.
- Only one parent/carer attends with their child at the college.
- Due to space limitations, we are unable to accommodate any pushchairs or prams.

Following assessments, we are also identifying students who are not yet making the desired levels of progress and consequently would benefit from additional support. The parents/carers of those students will be contacted to arrange a further face-to-face meeting in the College on Tuesday 16th January, to provide specific and agreed interventions for your child after the parent evening event.
