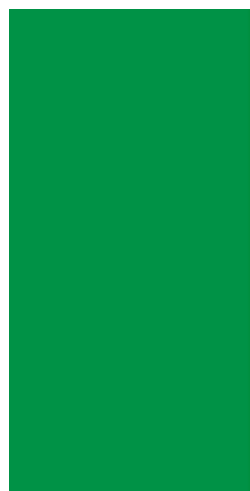

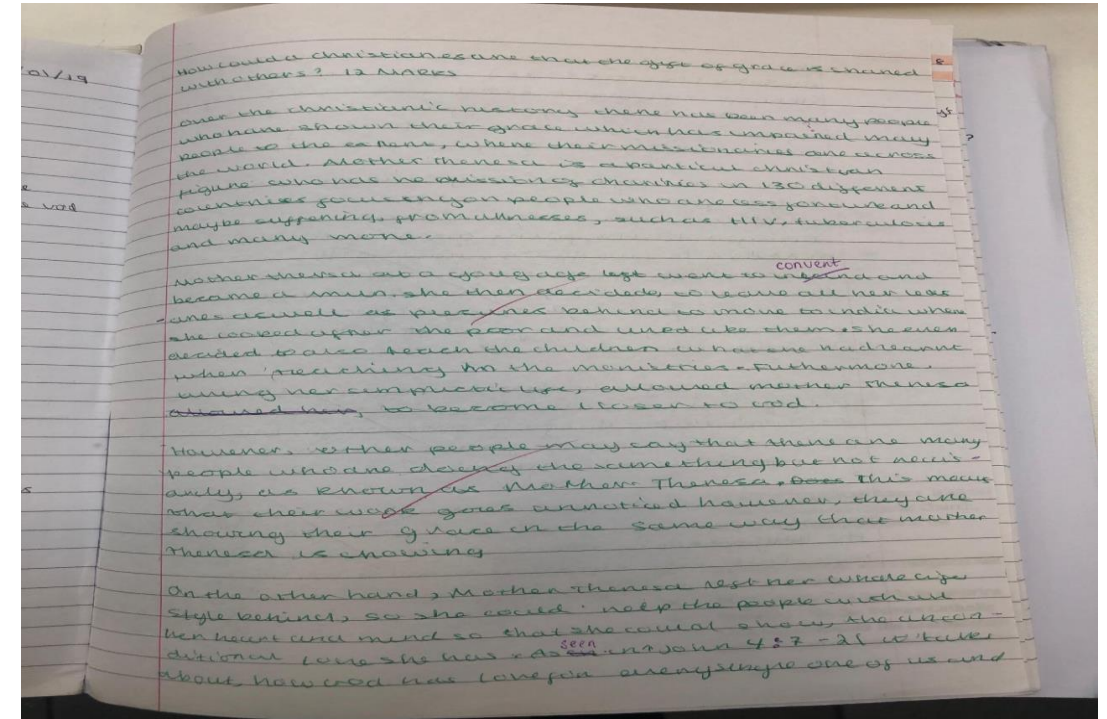
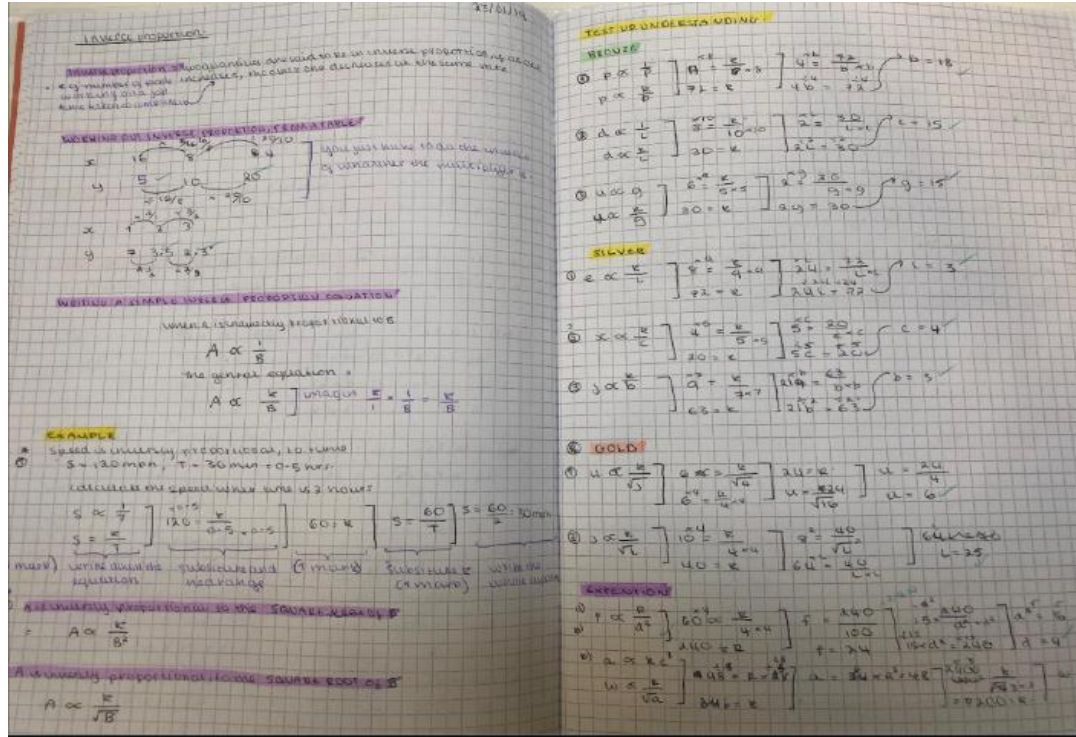

We encourage you to reflect on your impact you have on the environment around you.

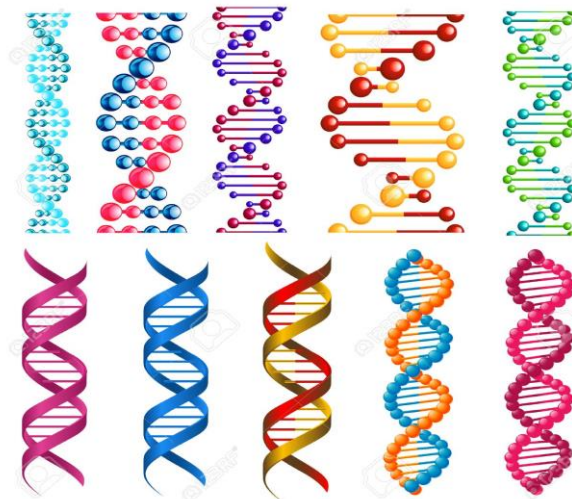
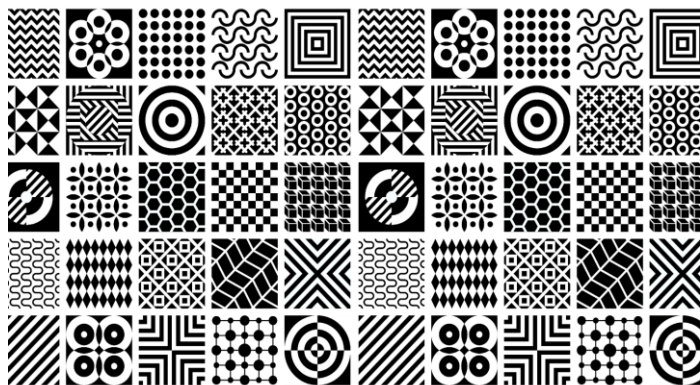
The eco committee will be hosting competitions for students to participate in, make sure to keep an eye out on the student notices!

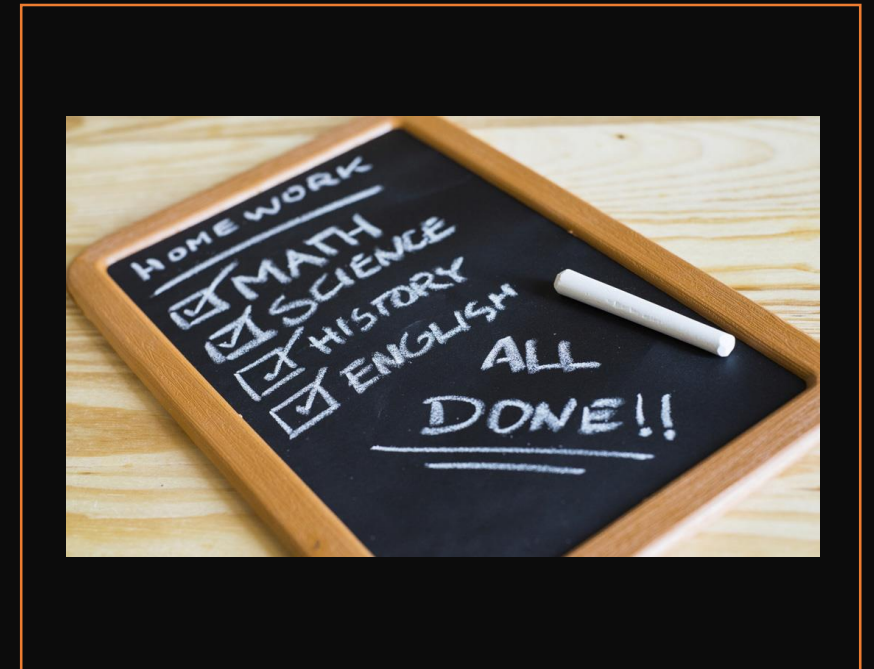

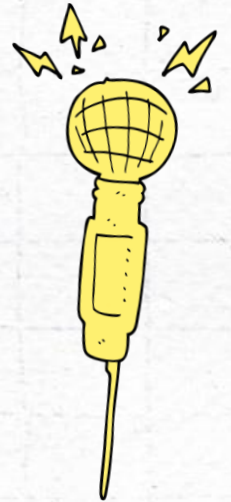
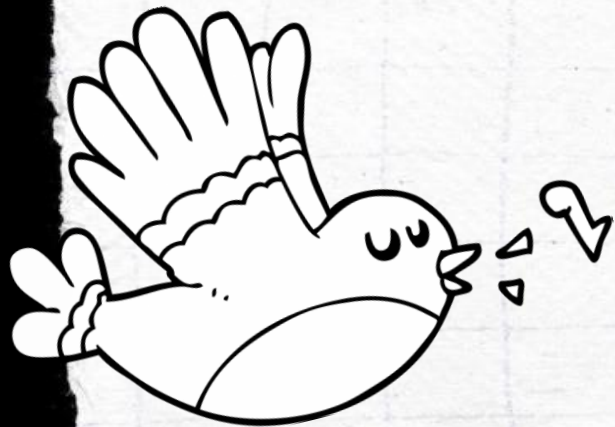
