Pathways & CRITERIA



- You will need at least grade 5 for GCSE English and Maths for A Level pathway
- Honours Pathway: up to 4 A levels. Link with Target Oxbridge (5 GCSE at grades 9–8)
- Scholars A level Pathway: Link with The Elephant Group (5 GCSEs at Grades 9–6. Science and Maths require grade 7 at GCSE level)
- Technical Pathway: Links with Career organisations (5 GCSEs at grades 9–5)
- Read the subject information carefully – different subjects have different entry requirements. This is available on the website and in the prospectus
- New courses/pathways are being explored for 2026–7
