Feast of St Mary Mazzarello

Wednesday 13th May

She was famous for her hard work in the vineyards and her "Window of Mornese," where she would look out at her community to see who needed help. Her spirituality focuses on **calmness, duty, and deep joy.**

The "Mornese Mission": 5 Daily Goals

Monday: The "Window of Care"

Mary Mazzarello used to look out of her window at night to check on the people in her village.

Mission: Look "outside yourself" today. Notice one person in your year group who looks stressed or lonely (especially those heading into exams) and offer them a word of encouragement.

Tuesday: The "Duty of Love"

One of Mary's most famous sayings was: *"Do your duty, but do it with a heart full of love."*

Mission: Choose your most boring or difficult task today (like a revision session or a tidy-up). Instead of grumbling, do it as a "gift" for God or for your future self.

Wednesday (Feast Day): The "Cheerfulness Challenge"

Mary believed that being grumpy was a sign of a "heavy heart." She wanted her students to be "bright like the sun."

Mission: Be the "Sun" in your classroom. Even if you are tired or stressed, keep a cheerful tone in your voice and see how it changes the mood of the people around you.

Thursday (Ascension): The "Feet on Earth, Heart in Heaven"

On Ascension Thursday, we remember Jesus returning to the Father. Mary taught that we should work hard on earth but always keep our hearts "reaching up."

Mission: Before you start a piece of work or an exam today, take **10 seconds** of silence. Offer the next hour to God and ask Him to stay with you while you work.

Friday: The "Stitch of Peace"

Mary was a seamstress who taught young women to sew. She told them that every single stitch they made was a prayer.

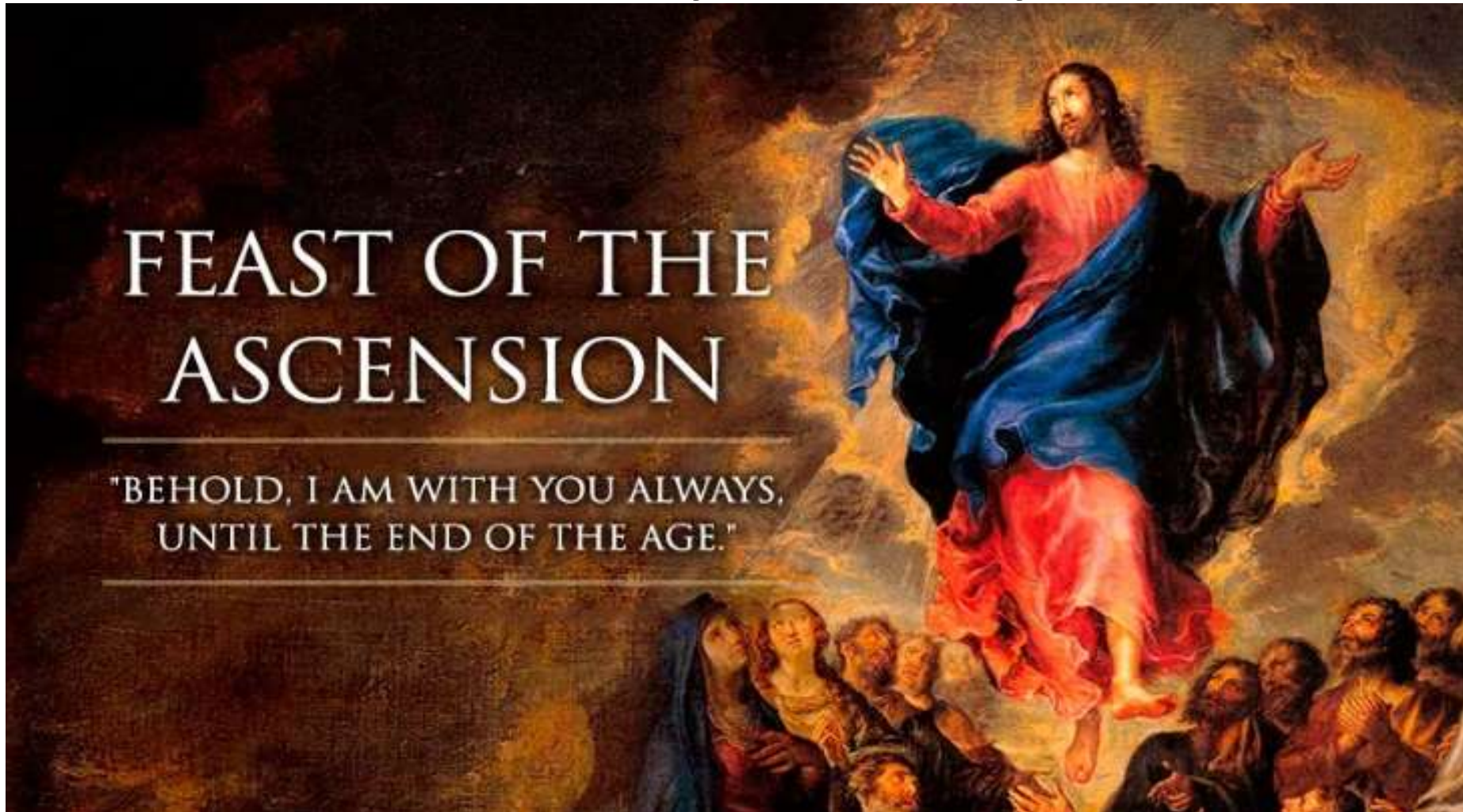

Letters to Pope Leo



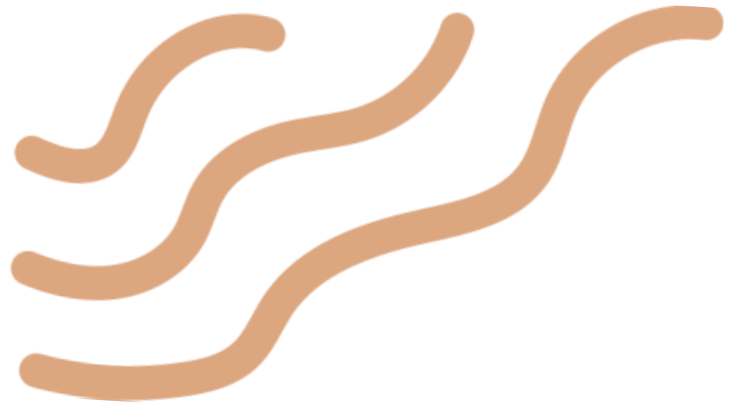

Food from the canteen is not allowed to be taken outside as it encourages rats/pigeons etc which is a health risk.



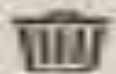
