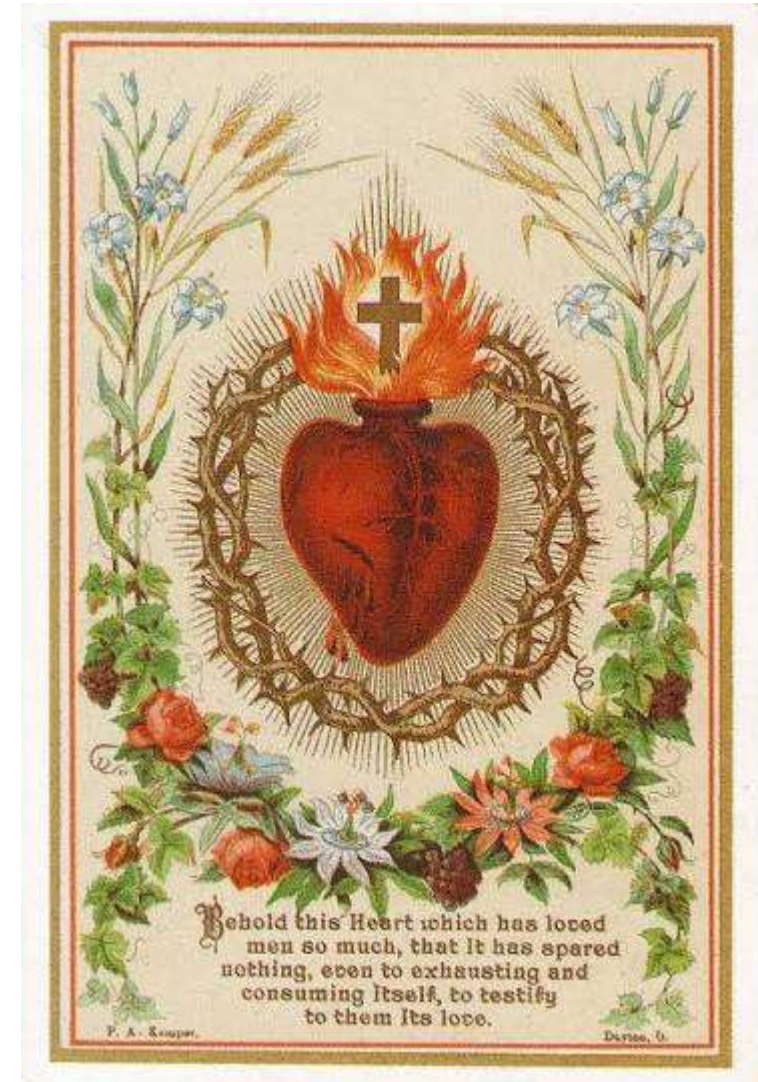

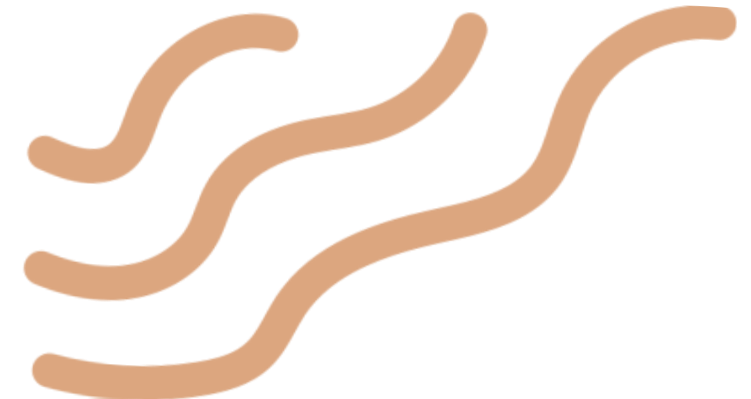
We're going to write a letter to Pope Leo.
