# *Liturgical Highlights for this Week;*

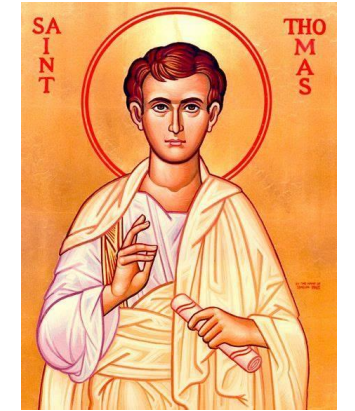
## **Monday, June 29: Solemnity of Peter and Paul:**
